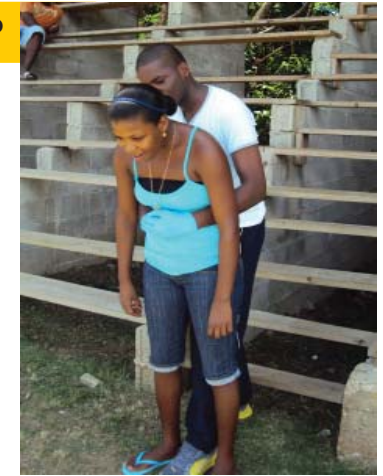
WHAT COURSES DOES ST JOHN OFFER?
